 the price of my land and no more
 he has got pay for all he done on
 this place the rest of my place has
 supported us and more too he has
 not had to buy us clothes our
 pair of shoes one knife is all that
 he has bought. bought them in
 1885.

Item 3 My Son J. D. Wofford + C. C. Wofford
 has had their part of my estate
 and more too they get no more.

Item 4 A. K. if he gets half the price of
 my land he is to pay the rest
 that are entitled 50 Dollars apiece
 if he buys the other part this is my
 Will We have about fifty Dollars
 worth of clothing and flour and
 other things.

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- Item 5 I do appoint my Son W. W. Wofford my Executor to attend to my business when I am gone and no more.
- Item 6 I have a vein of mittle running through my land that I forever except not sell it with the land. A. D. Wofford and C. C. Wofford has had their shares in it if it is worth anything then shall be equal in it with the rest in it.
- Item 7 A. M. Wofford if he pays off a note to Joseph Underwood the sum of Sixty dollars he will be equal with the rest of my heirs if one does not he gets nothing of mine. W. W. Wofford I pray you to see to your Mother that she gets justice in everything that is rite.
- Item 8 Settle with A. K. and give him what is rite if you can he has got an acct against me that is large I could bring an account larger than his that is just and sure. This Feb. 4th 1888.
