 in body and being desirous to settle my
 worldly affairs while I have strength to do
 so and being especially desirous of giving
 and securing a portion of my Estate to
 James H. Reques and Lydda & Frances the
 Children of William A. Reques of said
 County and also make some provisions
 for Louisa and Mordack my orphan
 Rased by me & who have lived with me
 Do make this my Last will and Testament
 hereby Revoking all wills by me at any
 time heretofore made and first commending
 my soul to god who gave it and my
 body I desire to be decently buried
 and my worldly Estate I Dispose as
 follows secondly I desire that all my
 Debts be paid; Thirdly I desire and
 direct that the Children of William
 A. Reques above mentioned have from
 my Estate one thousand Dollars that
 is to say James H. Reques to have
 five hundred and Lydda & Frances
 to have five hundred dollars if
 any of them should die before the
 Legacy then the survivors to take the one
 thousand this Legacy I have heretofore secured
 to them by a certain Deed by me made
 to them calling for one thousand dollars
 worth of Land and I mean by this will
 and the Deed that said Children in no
 Event shall have from my Estate more
 than one thousand dollars fourthly
 I desire and direct that Louisa and Mordack
 have from the monies raised from the
 sale of my property five hundred
 dollars in money

fourthly: I desire and direct that my
Executors hereafter appointed use enough
of the money raised from the sale of my
property to place a good Rail fence
around the grain yard near the residence
of William C. Reaves

Fifthly I desire and direct that
the residue of my Estate after paying the
above mentioned taxes be applied
to the building of a Meeting house
for the Baptist Denomination at a place
to be selected by Jesse Hunt E. H. Reaves
and A. F. Underwood and that
they three superintend the building of
the said Meeting House

sixthly I hereby appoint my friends
Dr John C. Chandler and A. F.
Underwood Executors of this my
last will and testament
in witness whereof the said
my will consisting of one sheet of
paper have set my hand & seal

this the 30th day of April 1875
