Will of H. H. Canley
In the name of God amen
I Henry H. Canley of Hancock
County in the County of White State
of Georgia being of sound mind and
memory and considering the uncertainty
of this frail and transitory life do there-
fore make ordain publish and declare
this to be my last Will and testament
That is to say First after all my lawful
debts are paid and discharged the residue
Estate real and personal I give bequeath
and dispose of as follows to wit To my
beloved Wife the Land and appertaining
situated therein with all my stock
Furniture and any thing else I
possess during the term of her natural
life and after her death to be divided
as follows

and I will and bequeath to my son Samuel
A Canley all my Interest in Lots of Land
Nos (38) Thirty eight and (39) Twenty seven
and a portion of Lot No 39 Thirty nine
that is all on the west side of the Chat-
tahoochee River containing one hundred and
twenty five acres more or less all being
in the 3rd dist of Originally Habersham
now White County in the State of Georgia
He said Samuel O Canley being bound
to pay all my lawful debts and to support
and take Care of my self and his mother
during our natural life time as his part
and in Consideration of the above pos-
sessions at our deaths all stock cattle Horses
and house hold Furniture

and I will and bequeath to my son John
M Canley all my Interest in Lot No 39
Thirty nine Commencing on South East side
of the Chattahochee River at a Conditional
Corner thence to the River thence down
said River in a North East direction to
the bend of the River thence on same
line N E to the original line thence
East on a line to a Conditional

Come made by Albert G. Ditner and myself
thence South East as will better show
Fence now made and considered the line
between me and Driar L. Ditner crossing
the old Unicoy Road at or near a spring
to the top of the Ridge thence West an
conditional line to the beginning corner all
in the 3rd dist of Originally Habersham
County and known as Lots of Land No
(37) Thirty nine containing 125 acres more or
less upon these conditions that he
pays Three hundred dollars to his sisters
and Brother To wit George H. Canley and
hundred dollars To Mary A. E. McMan One
hundred dollars To Hannah R. McMan
Fifty dollars. To Sarah L. Leonard Twenty
five dollars To Martha M. Gregory Twenty
five dollars allowing said John W.
Canley with Interest from the time he
gets title to the above Land three years
to pay the same in the above amt is
in consideration for the above stated
Deed - I Consider my sons William
and David R. Canley fully paid that
part of my Estate Five hundred dollars
in a settlement of merchandise
as partners in said

Likewise I make constitute and appoint
my said sons John W. and Samuel O.
Canley to be Executors of this my last
Will and testament hereby revoking all
former Wills by me made
