Item 2nd I direct (and will that all my just debts be
 paid as soon as practicable to which end I
 desire that such property as can be best and
 conveniently disposed of (and spared out of
 the Estate as may be necessary & sufficient
 for that purpose & the payment of my funeral
 expenses, (and no more, be sold either at
 public or private Sale as may be deemed best
 and the proceeds thereof applied to that pur-
 pose)

Item 3rd I bequeath to my wife Hannah. A.
 Black, for the use behoof and benefit of
 her and her present children during her nat-
 ural life or widowhood all the remainder
 of my property both real and personal.

Item 4th I further will & direct that the death or marriage
 of the said Hannah. A. Black, all the remain-
 ing property be sold (provided a mutual divis-
 ion with out sale can not be agreed upon
 between the parties) And divided equally
 among ~~them~~ and my children.
