 Will and testament hereby revoking and annulling
 all others heretofore by me made.

Item first I direct that my body be buried in
 @ decent and Christian like manner suitable to
 my circumstances and Condition in life my
 Soul I trust shall return to rest with God
 who gave it as I hope ^{for so long time} through the merits and
 atonements of the Blessed Lord and saviour
 Jesus Christ

Item second I desire and direct that all my just
 debts be paid without delay by my Executor here
 in after named and appointed

Item Third I give bequeath and demise to my beloved
 Wife Martha D. Cravin the East end of lot of
 land number one hundred and four (104) in the second
 district of originally Habersham now White County
 containing one hundred and twenty five (125)
 acres more or less together with all the farming
 tools and live stock remaining on my land at
 the time of my death to be for her support and
 maintenance during her life time or widowhood

Item 4th I give and bequeath to the Children of
 my son Isaac H. Cravin Three hundred dollars
 to be free from the debts and not subject in
 anywise to the debts of my said son Isaac
 H. Cravin for their support and maintenance

Item 5th in like manner I give and bequeath
 to my daughter Susan Morris one hundred dollars
 Item 6th in like manner I give and bequeath
 to my daughter Elizabeth C. Porter two hundred
 and fifty dollars

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter
 Nancy Porter one hundred and fifty dollars

Item 8th I give and bequeath to my youngest son Enoch B. Cravin all my right title and interest in to and of a certain parcel of Land situated lying and being in the second district of said County wherein I now have a saw mill and after a Merchant mill and from the deeds in my possession thought and proceed to be part of lot of land number eighty and (81) except so much as I have heretofore deeded to William Morris and also a triangle gone of land in the North East Corner of said lot the old road from where Marion Palmer now lives to Cleveland a Coneliter at line containing by Estimation one hundred and fifty acres (150) as his right and property as my only minor ~~there~~

Item 9 I desire at my death that all the ~~death~~ property that I may be possessed of at my death and not donated in the above named items to be sold and equally divided among my legal heirs to wit. that is after all the above specific donations are paid to the parties named by my Executor herein after named and at the death of my wife Martha D. Cravin the property in land and property to become part of my Estate for distribution among my legal heirs and this gift is in full of her right to dower

Item 10th The following are my legal heirs at Law to share in the proceeds of my property after the specific donations are given viz Isaac H. Cravins Children Susan Morris Eliza C. Porter named Porter and Enoch B. Cravin and Isaac H. Cravins to divide what they may receive equally among them

Item 11th In the gift to my wife Martha D. Cravin I desired in addition to this that she have all the household and kitchen furniture and what provisions on hand at my death in short every thing on hand at my death without further specification

Item 12th The notes I now hold on W. H. C. State is the right and property of the heirs (at Law) of my deceased son I. B. Cravin which I desire my Executor to collect

to said heirs Equally

Item 13th I hereby appoint my trustworthy friend Elijah
Alexander as guardian of my minor son
Enoch B. Cravin

Item 14. I hereby appoint and constitute my friend George
McGuilliam Executor of this my last Will and Testament
this December 9th 1876 John B. Cravin
