 atonements of the Blessed Lord and Saviour

Item second I desire and direct that all my just
 debts be paid without delay by my Executor here
 in after named and appointed

Item third I give bequeath and devise to my beloved
 wife Martha T. Cravins the East end of lot of
 land number one hundred and four (104) in the said
 district of originally Habersham now White County
 containing one hundred and twenty five (125)
 acres more or less together with all the farm
 tools and live stock remaining on my land at
 the time of my death to be for her support and
 maintenance during her life time or widowhood

Item 4th I give and bequeath to the children of
 my son Isaac H. Cravins three hundred dollars
 to be free from the debts and not subject in
 anywise to the debts of my said son Isaac

H. Cravins for their support and maintenance

Item 5th in like manner I give and bequeath
 to my daughter Susan Morris one hundred dollars

Item 6th in like manner I give and bequeath
 to my daughter Elizabeth C. Postle two hundred
 and fifty dollars

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my grand daughter
 Nancy Postle one hundred and fifty dollars

Item #9 give and bequeath to my youngest son Enoch
B. Cravins all my right title and interest in to and
of a certain parcel of Land situated lying and
being in the second district of said County
wherein I now live @ said mill and after
@ Merchant mill and from the deeds in my
possession thought and proved to be part of
lot of land number eighty one (81) except so much
as I have heretofore deeded to William Morris and
also @ triangle gone of land in the North East
corner of said lot the old road from where
Malcom Palmer now lives to Oldland @ Coneston
all land containing by estimation one hundred
and fifteen acres (115¹) as his right and property
as my only minor ~~heire~~

Item 9 I desire at my death that all the ~~the~~ ^{my} death
property that I may be possessed of at my death will not
be divided in the above named items to be
sold and equally divided among my legal
heirs to wit. that is after all the above specific
donations are paid to the parties named by
my Executor herein after named and at the
death of my wife Martha D. Cravins the property
in land and property to become part of my
estate for distribution among my legal heirs and
this gift is in full of her right to do over

Item 10th The following are my legal heirs at law
to share in the proceeds of my property after
the specific donations are given
viz Isaac H. Cravins Children Susan Morris
Eliza C. Porter named Porter and Enoch B. Cravins
and Isaac H. Cravins to divide what they may
receive equally among them

Item 11th In the gift to my wife Martha D. Cravins
I desire in addition to this that she have all
the household and kitchen furniture and what
provisions on hand at my death in short every
thing on hand at my death without further
specification

Item 12th The note I now hold on W. H. Gately is the
right and property of the heirs (at law) of
my deceased son J. A. Cravins which I desire
my Executor to pay to his ^{son} John Collected

To said heirs Equally
I hum 13th I hereby appoint my trustwrothy friend Elijah
A. Alexander as guardian of my minor son
Enoch B. Cravins

I hum 14. I hereby appoint and constitute my friend George
W. Quillian Executor of this my last will and testament
