all wills made by me at any time
heretofore and first I commit my

dust. And my worldly affairs as
follows- To E. J. Thurmond I will one
thousand dollars to be divided equally
between the children of E. J. Thurmond
and first wife Mary being nine in
all E. J. Thurmond one child past and
each child to draw one hundred dollars
with interest as it comes of age from
the date of my death - also I will to
Caroline Hix four hundred dollars for
the use of her and her children

Glen to this my will consisting of the
foregoing three sheets of paper have set
my hand and seal this 10th day of
Feb. 1874 John Glen
