absolutely and in fee simple all my real
estate the same being the home place where
I now live being one hundred and nine
acres just above J. D. Cooley's Mills.

Item 4
I direct that all my household and kitchen
furniture, live stock, &c. Buggies & harness &c.
in a word all my personal (estate) property
of whatever description be sold by my
Executors hereinafter named and the
proceeds equally divided between Mary
E. Glaze and her lawful heirs and
Louisa Amettie Payne and her lawful
heirs.

I give and bequeath all my property to my

life time and then to be sold and divided
as aforesaid.
