I give all my stock to my said
Husband to be used in the same manner

and maintenance of my children now or
hereafter and desire to with Samuel Dixey James
Isaac John Milton and Joseph

Item 4th I give unto my beloved Husband and Rebecca
Standridge a Life Estate in my Lands they to
be maintained out of the issues profits
arising from said Lands to wit the Lands
described in a deed dated Feb 6th 1873 made
by Joseph H Standridge to me and recorded in
the Clerk's office of said County in Book 73 Page 22
and after the death of the said Joseph H
& Rebecca Standridge and when my youngest
child arrives at majority then the said Lands to
be sold and the proceeds equally divided between
the persons named in the second item of this my
will said land not to be sold or encumbered till
said youngest child comes of age same as above
charged

Item 5th I hereby appoint my Husband Joseph H Standridge
guardian of my minor children their persons &
property and I hereby release him from giving
bond in making annual returns

Item 6th I appoint Amos J Turner Executor of
this my last will and Testament and release
him from making annual returns
I hereby direct and require of my
Husband in consideration of the bequest
here in to him given that he pay the cost
of the probate of this my Will July 18th 1883
