make @ disposition of the property with which
@ kind providence has blessed me I do therefore
make this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking and annulling all others by me
heretofore made,

First I desire and direct that my body be buried
in @ decent and Christian like manner suitable
to my circumstances and condition in life
my soul I trust shall return to God who gave
it as I hope for salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Lord and saviour
Jesus Christ

secondly I desire and direct that all my last debts be
paid without delay by my Executor herein after
named and appointed

Thirdly I give bequeath and devise to my son Henry
Turner one ^{undivided} half of Lot of land number ninety
two in the third district of originally Habersham
County now White County containing one
hundred and fifty Acres more or less with all
the rights members and appurtenances to
said Lot of Land in any wise belonging
forever in fee simple

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Bessie
McBary wife of James McBary for her sole and
separate use one undivided half of (a part of)
Lot of Land number ninety two in the third
district of originally Habersham County now
White County containing one hundred and
fifty Acres more or less with all and singular
the rights members and appurtenances to said
Lot of Land in any wise belonging forever
in fee simple free from all charge and
limitation whatsoever to her own proper use
benefit and behoof forever with full power
to dispose of the same by Will or otherwise
as she may deem proper

Fifth And I hereby constitute and appoint my friend
James West Executor of this my last Will and
Testament this July 10th 1871 Micager^W Turner {L.S.
signed sealed and published by Micager Turner as
his last Will and Testament in the presence of us the
undersigned who subscribed our names here to in
the presence of said testator at his special instance
and request and in the presence of each other
July 10th 1871
