want my wife Catharine buried decently
and have a good substantial Rock wall put
around her grave after she dies by a good
Rock mason. I leave all my real Estate to
my wife Catharine with all the appurtenances
thereon for a support during her life as
long as she remains a Widow and to keep
up the farm. I want there be a surplus after
after her support and the farm kept in good
order then it is to be sold by my Executor
and divided equally with my children in the event
of her marriage, my wife Catharine then the
whole property real Estate and personal property
to be sold by my Executor and divided equally
with my Children. I want the Horse and
the oxen kept on the farm to keep it up
also my wife Catharine to have one Milk
Cow and my ox Wagon I want all the
sheep in my flock sold and all the hogs
except four or six head sold and as much
of the other stock as my Executors may think
best. I want my son John & Susie
to have as much of my Land as he can
cultivate each year as long as he stays
with his mother peacefully. I give to my
son John & Susie one white and red spotted
Cow one black Lipper also two red and
white spotted Calves one white sow and
two pigs and the rest on James Glen
to make him equal with the other
Children. When my Estate is sold for
debtors I want my three children

of my Estate divided with all my
children. If my son Howell C. Sasser
never returns then his share of my

to be executors of this my last Will
and Testament.
