being parts of lots of Land nos 114 & 115 in the
second district of originally Habersham
County White containing according to estimate
one hundred acres with all the right and
appurtenances there unto pertaining except
one half interest in the above lands which
belongs to my son Geo H Quillian

I do further bequeath to my beloved wife
all of the household and kitchen furniture
stock and farming utensils upon the place
together with my Wagon buggy & provisions
for the family on hand

I do further bequeath to my wife my one
half interest in stock and trade moneys
in and half interest in Blacksmith shop
with all the half belonging to the firm of Geo
H D Quillian

4th I do bequeath to my beloved wife all of
above named articles and all the prop-
erty owned by me the same to be used

her own maintenance and the maintenance
of the children who are yet with us under
the direction and over sight of the Executor
hereinafter appointed

5th I do further direct that my wife shall have
the use and benefit of all my property
for the above named purposes during the
time of her natural life in widowhood
if there should be anything left at her
death or marriage I desire the same to be
equally divided among my legal heirs

Jr & William Ashby & William Hornell

Osborn & William John William
