

Georgia In the name of God amen. I
White County Samuel Parker Denmore of the
State Pard Co aforesaid do hereby right
both as respects myself and my family
that I should make a disposition of the
property with which a kind providence
has blessed me I therefore make this
my last Will & Testament.

Item I I desire and direct that my
body be buried in a decent and christian
like manner suitable to my circumstances
and condition. My Soul I trust shall
return to rest with God who gave it. I
trust for eternal salvation through the
blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
whose religion I have professed and as
I humbly hope have enjoyed for many years.

Item II I desire and direct that all
my just debts be paid so soon as
convenient by Executors hereafter named
out of the proceeds of my Estate.

Item III I give and devise to my beloved
daughter Mary Elizabeth Denmore parts
of Lots Nos 53, 50, 54 & 68 constituting
the farm on which I live commencing
at the first branch North of the Shop
at the head of said branch running down
said branch to the big Road running from
Cleveland to Blairsville running ^{the} north
with said Road to the next branch thence
down said branch south course to the creek
thence down the middle of said creek to
the line at Winklers fence giving her
all the above described premises North
and West of said mentioned line

Item IV Give and devise to my beloved
wife Anna Denmore with whom I have
lived in the strictest quiet and love
for many years all the balance of my
Farm to wit No 53, 50, 54 & 68 to a

above mentioned until my youngest child becomes of age at which time if my beloved wife is still living I desire that said premises shall not be sold that she may live on said land so long as she lives unmolested in any manner free from any administration whatever

Item **V** I give and devise to my wife Annis I consume all my stock of horses cattle hogs & sheep together with all my farming utensils wagons &c. together with all my household and kitchen furniture to her own use for the support of and Education of my children hereafter named and I further direct my wife to give unto my son Fletcher Plunk some one horse of his own choice of all the stock that is on the premises at the time of my death.

Item **VI** I desire that if my wife should die before my youngest child becomes of age that said lands and property should not be sold until said youngest child becomes of age.

Item **VII** but when said youngest child becomes of age if my wife is dead I desire that said lands and property shall be sold and the proceeds of said property shall be divided equally amongst my wife children to wit William Clemons James Hiligan Guillian Ciliaus Frank Nancy Caroline & Louisa Payne.

I desire if my wife is not dead at the time of my youngest child becoming of age that she still remain on said land as long as she live

Item VIII I desire that so soon as I depart
this life that my Daughter Mary
Elizabeth Deansmore take possession of
the lands heretofore given to her in this
will but that she is to have no power
to sell said lands until my youngest child
becomes of age or until the whole Farms
sold according to the above will

Item 8. I constitute and appoint my
beloved wife Anna Deansmore Executrix
and my son Fletcher Deansmore my
Executor to this my last will and
Testament This 23rd April 1864
