I give and bequeath and direct to
my beloved wife with whom I have lived in
peace and quiet and love for fifty years all
my personal and stock and household furniture
to her and dispose of to her more benefit during
her natural life and for the same to be disposed
of agreeable to her desire after her death.

I then I give and bequeath to my son Samuel
one hundred acres of land more or less being
the South Side of lot A 20 and a part of
lot A 5 being the northeast corner of said
lot A 20 in the second district of the original
Survey commencing at the original line
between the said Samuel Standridge and
Oliver Smith running up the main leading
ditch to mouth of the horse lot branch thence
up said branch to the head of said branch thence
a straight line northwest to the original on the
mountain.

I then I give to my daughter Alvina twenty
five acres of land more or less being a part of
lot A 5 in the second district of the original
Survey being the northwest corner of said lot
commencing at a confluence of a stream corner
and running thence up the leading creek ditch
to the original line.

I then I give to my son Joseph
twenty five acres of land more or less being
part of lot A 20 in the second district of the original
