Know all men by the presence that I William Kinsey of the County of White and State of Georgia Considering the uncertainty of this life and being of sound mind and memory do make declare and publish this my last will and testament

First I give and bequeath unto my beloved sons Robert L Kinsey and Mrs P Kinsey all that North half of Lot of Land No 106 situated in the second district of Formerly Habersham now White County to be divided as follows to Commence with the old North line and run with the old Cross Fence up the hollow to the top of the hill thence across the East end of the little field until it strikes Schuys Road the West half I give to Robert L Kinsey and the East half to William P Kinsey

Provided the said Robert L Kinsey and Mrs P Kinsey shall permit my daughters Ann Kinsey and Margaret Kinsey to remain on and have the use of the ^{named} land

in wish to occupy the same also my other two daughters Rebella Hamby and Elizabeth Goddard shall have the privilege of living on the Land as long as they live provided they clear and fence all the Land they occupy but if either of the above named daughters marry they shall by that act forfeit all claims to the further use of the aforesaid named Land

all my mechanical tools shall be Equally divided between W D Kinsey and Peter R Kinsey all the farming utensils shall belong to my daughters occupying the Farm

I give and bequeath to my two daughters Margaret and Ann Kinsey all my sheep and Hogs I also give and bequeath all my mixed Real and personal property to the above named Margaret and Ann Kinsey to have and to hold as their property for ever

In Testimony Whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament contained an one sheet of paper subscribed my name and set my seal this 31st day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six
