

The State of Georgia & I Ezra W Green being impeded with the uncertainty of human
Whitfield County } life and of remembering and disposing in my old and feeble
and declare this as my last will and testament to wit

1st I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Julia Green during her
lifetime the two whole lots of land I now being lots numbered one thousand
and Ninety Two and one thousand and Ninety Three, together with all the
household and kitchen furniture attached to the place, in the event it should
be unvariable or necessary, or should to the wish of my said daughter Julia to sell the
said estate above bequeathed it is my will that to complete a perfect bill of sale
to the said estate above bequeathed that the signature of my said daughter Julia
must be joined to the signature of the executors of this my last will and testament
in the event of the sale of the above bequeathed real estate to my said daughter
during her lifetime it is my will that the proceeds of such sale shall be
inclosed as soon as practicable in some prominent way or in the purchase of other
real estate which shall come to the benefit or belong to my said daughter Julia
during her lifetime and in the event of the marriage of my said daughter
that then the said estate bequeathed to my said daughter Julia or the proceeds of
the proceeds of the sale above supposed, shall be equally divided among all my children.

2nd In clearing up the affairs of my estate should my executors deem it necessary to
properly to meet such claims against my estate I hereby empower the said executors
to sell the two half lots of land I now being lots numbered two thousand and Ninety Six and two thousand and Ninety
Seven to proceeds of such sale to be applied to satisfy said claims, if no necessity
should arise for the sale of said lands I give devise and bequeath said two half
lots of land to my daughter Julia Green subject to the same condition and restrictions
upon which the two whole lots of land were bequeathed in the first article of the
my last will and testament

3rd It is my will that the personal estate of which I may be possessed of with
the exception above made of the household and kitchen furniture shall be equally
divided among all my children

4th It is my will and desire that the property belonging to my estate
shall be kept together as much as possible and that the proceeds arising from
the farm shall without affecting the rights bequeathed to my daughter Julia for
the support maintenance and education of my children

5th I hereby constitute and appoint my brother James Green and two
executors to this my last will and testament
