Georgia In the name of God Amen I John Stancee
of the County of Whitfield and State of Georgia being of
advanced age but of sound mind and in a delicate state of
health deem it right and proper both in respect to myself
and family that I should make a disposition of the property
with which a kind Providence hath blessed me withal do therefore
hereby make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all
others heretofore made

I do desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent Christian
like manner my soul I trust will return to rest with God who
gave it so I desire and direct that all of my just debts be paid without
delay by my executors hereafter appointed God I give grant and
bequeath unto my beloved Sons George W. Stancee and Andrew
I Stancee Lot of Land no fifteen in the Eleventh district of the
Third Section of the County and State aforesaid with all the rights
members and appurtenances there unto belonging jointly in fee simple
All the farming tools Smith Tools Cattle Hogs that belongs to me
I give unto my son A. J. Stancee which is to be used for the
use and benefit of my family as long as they remain at
home with them and to have a Cow and

Calf his daughters Martha and Sarah At the age of Twenty
one years if any or all of my daughters should marry before the
age of twenty one years they are to have a cow and Calf at the
time they marry all of my sheep I give unto my wife Catherine
Stancee to dispose of as she thinks proper Also all the house
hold property I give to wife Catherine Stancee during her natural
life and after her death the said property to be equally divided between
my daughters Mary Margaret Martha and Sarah Stancee
I direct that who ever of my sons have said tract of Land the
proceeds of the same is to go to the raising and maintaining my
wife & family as before directed George W. Stancee and A. J. Stancee
to give each of my daughters when ever they come of the age of
Twenty one years fifty dollars each Mary Margaret Martha and
Sarah also one woman saddle such as can be had that is Margaret Martha
and Sarah I constitute and appoint John Stancee Jr and George W. Stancee
my executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have here
so subscribed my name and affixed my seal this the Twenty fifth
