Item second

I desire and direct that all
my last debts be paid without
delay by my executors hereafter
named

My creditors should be delayed of their
right. especially as there is no necessity
for delay

I give and devise to my beloved wife galzer with whom I have lived for the last twenty years. Lot of Land number two hundred & forty in the 12th district of Oregonally Dooley new Wilcox County containing of two hundred and two and a half acres closing ^{to} natural ar widow hood and at the death ar married of my said wife galzer the said lot of Land and its appurtenances to be sold and equally divided among my children I also devise to my said wife twenty head of stock cattle also twenty head of stock hogs as she may choose one horse & cart and all property that may be herin devised to my said wife after her decease ar ~~my~~ marriage I devise to be sold and equally divided among my children I also devise to my said wife all the cooking utensils & farming tools also one Bed & Head & furniture Ther unto Beloning I also devise to my daughter Mary one Bed & Head and furniture also my daughter Susan one Bed & Head & furniture also my daughter Elizabeth one Bed & Head & furniture also I devise to my son Thomas one bed & Head & furniture also my son David

also I devise to my sons Thomas & David
one share each

Item fourth

I devise & direct that in the
Event of the death of any my children
without issue the property to said
child to equally divided among my
other children

Item fifth I Devise and direct that my
son Williams daughter Mattie Drew and
have the portion of my property that
my son Williams would have if alive

Item 6th I devise & direct that Lot of Land
number two hundred forty one in
12th district of originally Dade now
Waring County be sold and equally
divided among my five oldest children
viz Green Mills Anna Cynthia Elizabeth
and my grand daughter Mattie

Item 7th I Constitute and appoint my
two sons Green and Mills and
James Owens Executors to this
my Last Will and testament
This 23rd September 1873
