and Mary Johnson of the County of Wilcox and State of Georgia being of Sound and disposing mind and memory and being desirous to settle our worldly affairs which we have strength so to do that we have published this our last Will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by us at any time here to fore made and first we commend our souls to God who gave them and our worldly estate we dispose of as follows First it is our will and desire that the whole of our estate remain together and at our death after paying our debts to go to our only Caroline Wiggins now Caroline Foster and her bodily heirs and if the said Caroline Foster should die and have no heirs then it is our will and desire that Andrew Foster the husband of Caroline Foster should have it In witness whereof the said James Johnson and Mary Johnson to this our wills consisting of the foregoing one sheet of paper have set our hands and seals this the 24 day of February 1871
