received I furthermore give to each and every
one of my first set of children five dollars
to each one of them

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Therefore I give to my beloved
Wife Minny and here I am naming during
her widowhood with whom I have lived

for the strictest quiet and save for
 twenty seven years lot of land
 number seventy-nine for the twelfth
 12 District of Wilcox County Originally
 Doily containing two hundred two and a
 half acres with all the rights members and
 appertinences to said lot of land
 in my wife appertaining
 it belonging free from all charges or simulation
 what ever to their own proper use benefit
 and behoof for ever I also give and bequeath
 to my wife and her children in the same
 unreserved manner all of my horses and
 cattle and flocks all kinds all without
 reserved simulation
