Dollars for the payment of which sum to the said Judges and their successors we bind ourselves our Heirs, Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firm by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this *first* day of *February* 18 *19*

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that whereas the said *Mary Favor* is this day appointed Guardian to *Henry Favor* Orphan of *John Favor* but now if the said *Mary* do well and truly demean *her self* as Guardian aforesaid agreeable to the duties of Guardianship bearing even date herewith and agreeable to Law in such case made and provided then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force an virtue.
