I do give and bequeath to my Beloved Children, Elizabeth, Janet, Thomas, John, Samuel, William & Micajah all my Title claim Interest or demand and to a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred acres lying and being in the State of Virginia Campbell County upon the North fork Clinch to them and their heirs of their Bodies lawfully begotten forever.

I do appoint my beloved wife Sarah, my son John & my friend Benjamine Baldwin, the executor of

this my last will & Testament.
