

The Will of Samuel Cochran.

State of Georgia Wilkes County. In the name of
God Amen! I Samuel Cochran of the State
and County above written being weak in Body
yet perfect in memory & senses do make
this my last will and testament hereby Revok-
ing all others. Impressed:
I lend unto my beloved Wife Sarah during
her natural life or so long as she continues
in her widowhood state all my Lands
and Tenements whereon I now live with
all and singular rights members appertain-
ments and utensils belonging thereto,
and at her death or marriage to be Equally
divided between my three youngest Sons,
Samuel, William, and Micajah to them
and their heirs lawfully begotten by their
bodies forever.

I do give and bequeath to my Beloved
Children, Elizabeth, Jennet, Thomas, John,
Samuel, William & Micajah all my title
claim Interest or demand to a certain tract
or parcel of Land containing three hun-
dred acres lying and being in the State
of Virginia Campbell County upon the
North fork of Pinck to them and the
heirs of their Bodies lawfully begotten
forever.

I do further lend unto my beloved
wife Sarah during her natural life
or so long as she continues a Widow,
all my stock of horses cattle & hogs
with all my House Furniture, and

her death or marriage to be Equally divid-
ed between my three youngest children
Samuel, William, and Micajah to them
& the heirs lawfully begotten by their bodies
forever.

It is my desire farther that my three
youngest sons, Samuel, William & Mica-
jah be continued together on my plan-
tation and from the profits thereof
be Educated. Also it is my desire that
they may be furnished with a young
House as they become of age at the dis-
cretion of their mother.

Whereas my son John has re-
ceived his equal part of my property
during my life. I now give and
bequeath to him only five pounds to
be raised out of the Sale of my Lands
in Virginia to him & the heirs forever.

of October, one thousand seven hundred
and ninety one.

25th July 1791.

Appeared before me Richard Johnson
and Robert Leverett who by me being
severally sworn on the Holy Evangelist
of almighty God do depose and say
that they seen the within named Samuel
Cochran sign seal publish and declare
the within to be his last Will and Testa-
ment and that at the time of his doing
the same he was of sound and dis-
posing mind memory and under-
standing and that they at his request
subscribe their names as Witnesses to
the same - — proved & approved before
me the day & year above said
Edw'd Jones, R. P.
