Know all men by these presents that

Mathew Favor

admit of John Favor

Deceased and

John Chancy

held and firmly bound unto his Excellency the
Governor of said State for the time being and his
successors in office the full sum of one hundred dollars
for the true payment of said sum we bind ourselves
our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly, jointly,
and severally, by these presents, sealed with our seals of
office this 12th day of August 1839.

Now the condition of the recognizance is
such that if the above bound Mathew Favor do
aforesaid shall with true and lawful intent
Thomas Green and his son Alexander Green
their County at our next Superior Court to be held
in said County on the third morning of the next
term the said Thomas Green and Alexander
Green stand charged with having unlawfully
feloniously killed & carrying away one hog and
several others very valuable the property of
the said John Favor Decd. that if he should
continue or be cast in said Case that he will
pay off costs and damages which may be awarded
against him. Then the above recognizance to be
good otherwise to be and remain in full force and
effect.
