Wilkinson County I must also I give & bequeath
June the 12th 1872 my soul to God this year is
and my body to the dust. And after all my
just debts are paid, I give the housestead to my
dear wife to live on during life or widowhood
but the right and title of Number 107 in the
3rd dist said County I give to my two youngest
sons Daniel Franklin and William Harrison
Cutlaur to be equally divided between them
two sons and all my children that is not
married is to have a bed and bedding
Said Childrens names D F Cutlaur Sarah E
Cutlaur Wm Harrison Cutlaur Cynthia A Cutlaur
Nancy Jane Cutlaur Bruner H Cutlaur all to
have equal beds and bedding. My Young-
est Child Francis McInerney is to receive
leaves to her two hundred dollars in Money to
Clothes and School and Board said Child, and
if said Child should die, then it is to be divided
with ~~the~~ the remaining heirs. I appoint my
son Bentley Cutlaur Jr to be executor to my
will & we I think to be worthy. I also desire
that each daughter shall have a Cow & Calf
or its equivalent and also ten dollars in
Money and as my dear wife has lost her
Speech and part of her reason I desire that the
rest property shall be sold and that she may
be taken Care of while she lives, the proceeds of
property money notes &c and if there should
be any thing over it is to be equally divided
among my daughters. And if there is not
enough property to cover all that I have portioned
off then I will the different shares so that
the mother shall be Cared for and if there
is anything after death my desire is that
it shall be equally divided among the living
children and if there should be any collection
of old papers the same is to be equally divided
among all the children. I also give and bequeath
to my son Bentley Cutlaur in the North east half
of lot of land that he now lives on No 108
in the 3rd of said County the line to stand
that I made.
