 and my body to the dust. And after all my
 just debts are paid, I give the homestead to my
 dear Wife to live on during life or widowhood.
 But the right and title of Number 107 in the
 3rd dist said County I give to my two Youngest
 Sons Daniel Franklin and William Harrison
 Outlaw to be equally divided between them
 two sons and all my Children that is not
 married is to have a bed and bedclothing
 Said Childrens names D. F. Outlaw Sarah E.
 Outlaw Wm Harrison Outlaw Cynthia A. Outlaw
 Nancy Jane Outlaw Francis H. Outlaw, all to
 have equal beds and bedclothing. My Young-
 est Child Francis M. Innetta is to receive
 leave to her two hundred dollars in Money to
 clothe and school and board said Child, and
 if said Child should die then it is to be divided
 with the remaining heirs. I appoint my
 son Beatty Outlaw Jr to be executor to my
 Will when I think to be worthy. I also devise
 that each daughter shall have a Cow & Calf
 or its equivalent and also ten dollars in
 Money and as my dear wife has lost her
 speech and part of her reason I desire that the
 real property shall be sold and that she may
 be taken care of. While she lives the proceeds of
 property money votes &c and if there should
 be any thing over it is to be equally divided
 among my daughters and if there is not
 enough property to cover all that I have pointed
 off then Curtail the different shares so that
 the mother shall be cared for and if there
 is anything after death my desire is that
 it shall be equally divided among the living
 children and if there should be any collection
 of old papers the same is to be equally divided
 among all the children. I also give and bequest
 to my son Beatty Outlaw Jr the north east half
 of lot of land that he now lives on No 108
 in the 3rd of said County the line to stand
 that I made.
