Item 1st I desire that my body shall be buried in a decent

it is I hope for final Salvation through the merits
of his Son who died for the redemption of fallen man

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Jackson
during her Natural life the home place whereon
I now live being Lot of Land No 222 in the
District of said County also Lots Nos 322
323- Lying east of the home lot in said
District & adjoining the River Swamp each
Containing 222 acres more or less bearing the
purpose named in them the North end above
the second floor of the dwelling

Item 3rd I dispose of my Stock as follows
I give to my son James H Jackson
brown bay horse Bob to my son Benjamin F
Jackson Mare mule Colt Mare and a horse
Colt And to my said wife my small horse
all the rest of my Stock of all kinds horses
Cattle hogs sheep Cattle goats &c and also
household and Kitchen furniture Fencing
including Carts wagons and all other like
on the home place I give and bequeath to
said wife during her life and at her death
to go to and rest in my two said sons
share alike but should any of said sons
unprofitable on the place then and in that event
said wife with the consent of my two sons may
and dispose of the same whensoever the father
thereof as she and they may see proper
Nevertheless that any or all of said sons
be held up necessary for the purposes hereof

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Mary and her two children Henry and William
they may live fit to occupy the
half of lot of land No 222

hereinafter mentioned in Item 2^d being the front and Room on the second floor to be held and occupied by them so long as they may desire to use and occupy the same

Item 5th I will and direct that whatever may be due at my death may be collected without delay and applied to the payment of such debt if any as I may owe and the balance if any to go as provided in Item 3^d to my wife for life and at her death to my two sons heretofore named including any Cash which may be on hand at the time of my death & should there be any sum prove inadequate to the payment of debts a deficiency is to be supplied by sale of stock as provided in Item 3^d

Item 6th I give and bequeath in fee simple to my two daughters Edith C. Wade and Nancy E. McCallum I have and share & divide in equal ~~parts~~ ^{shares} my one half interest in the following lots of land in the second district of Appling County to wit: 595-641-642-643-644-645-692 and 603 Containing in the aggregate three thousand & eleven (3011) acres more or less also lot 10 in the district of originally Inverness County containing 498 acres more or less being the only lot of originally Inverness County land owned at this date by me

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Rankin the amount when collected which may be due on the note of her husband John S. Rankin said note being for the principal sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) the same to be collected by executor hereinafter appointed and invested for or paid over to my said daughter Sally

8 I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary B. Robinson wife of Andrew Robinson in fee simple the north half of lot of land No 298 in the third district of said County of Wilkinson the same being all that I own of said lot since conveying a portion of the same to Sally Rankin say No 298 more or less and an other portion to Adam Greene 20 acres more or less being to my daughter Mary B. Robinson and one more of 40 acres ~~more~~ ^{more} No 299 in said district containing said 40 acres and being all that I own of said No 299 also I own of said lot No 347 in the 1st district of said County containing 157 acres more or less

I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin H. Jackson all the residue of my land as not herein before disposed of in equal portions to and share alike to them and each of them and their heirs and assigns forever in full simple I also give and bequeath to my said sons after the death of my said wife all the property named in Item 2 of this will being the same place &c to them and each of them share and share alike and to their heirs

Item 10th I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin H. Jackson and my grandson Henry Clay Jackson 100 acres more or less of lot No 262 in the 4th district of said County of Wilkinson known as the Calson lot to them share and share alike

Item 11th I give and bequeath to my two sons Benjamin H. Jackson and Francis H. Jackson all the residue of my land as not herein before disposed of in equal portions to and share alike to them and each of them and their heirs and assigns forever in full simple I also give and bequeath to my said sons after the death of my said wife all the property named in Item 2 of this will being the same place &c to them and each of them share and share alike and to their heirs

Item 12 I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Isaac Jasper H. Wall executor of this my will and testament this May 20th 1873
