Hobbs and who has ever been kind and
affectionate to me my entire
Stock of cattle sheep and hogs
also my house hold and Kitchen
furniture and also all other
property I may disposed of

appoint my nephew James Hobbs
Executor of this my last will and
Testament this 19 day of May 1866
