stock of hogs All the Cotton now in
the field Also the present growing
Crop All the above named Property
to be Excepted to Beatrice Cox; free
from all charges or limitation what
ever to be her own Property use and
benefit and behoof All of the remain-
der of my effects consisting
of fifty head of Cattle more
or less Sixty acres of land more
or less lying north west of Spalden
Court House in 7th District of said
County one lot of land lying on
Bachmanick and Albany Sts in
8th District of North County Original
Lot no 297, All notes &c to be
sold and equally divided between
my four Children, share for share
Beatrice Cox, Starker M Cox
Auld Catron Malanda Henderson
Second 2nd I hereby constitute and
appoint my son Starker M Cox
