Sir

You are hereby notified that your claim for pension, No. 12585, under act of February 14, 1871, has been allowed at eight dollars per month, commencing February 14, 1871, payable at the Pension Agency in Washington, D. C.

Your pension certificate has been issued and sent to the Pension Agent at Washington, D. C., who will forward to you, upon receipt thereof, and quarterly thereafter, proper vouchers for payment thereupon. The note indorsed upon said vouchers will explain when and how they shall be executed by you, and how the payment thereupon will be made.

The fee to be paid your attorney for the prosecution of your claim is \$10.
