NO pedigree can be completed without reference to Parish Registers. It is obviously a matter of prime importance to genealogists that they should be rendered accessible by means of printing them.

This Series aims, by a County system, at printing the whole of the Parish Registers in England (except such as have been printed already by others), dealing in the first instance with the Marriages, from the beginning of each Register down to the early years of the 19th century.

The Marriage entries are by far the most important part of every register—Marriages being much the most numerous of the missing links in pedigrees, while at the same time they are the most difficult to discover, owing to the uncertainty of their whereabouts—if anything at all is known of a family it is usually known where to look for most of its baptisms or burials—but this rule does not apply to its matrimonial alliances. Hence the need of first printing the marriages of the whole of each county, and so not only preserving that portion of the Registers from the risk of total loss, but making them more accessible to the genealogical student.

A further advantage is that, owing to the comparatively small number of marriage entries as contrasted with baptisms and burials, it is possible to make such rapid progress with this work that most counties, if supported by a good body of subscribers willing to take two volumes at 10/6 each per annum, can have the whole of their Marriage Registers printed within a reasonable period, enabling subscribers themselves to see the accomplishment of the work and

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have the volumes upon their own shelves, whereas to print the whole of each Parish Register *verbatim*, greatly desirable though that be, one hundred years would scarcely suffice.

This scheme was started by the late Mr. Phillimore in 1897, and such progress has been made that in some counties two-thirds of the parishes have now been printed. In those counties where the marriage entries in the registers of a large co-terminus area have thus been made accessible (as, for instance, in Nottinghamshire, where all the southern half of the county has been done), the printed volumes have proved to be the *key* to the genealogy of nearly all the families in that district. It is easy to get the baptisms and burials when once all the Marriages and the places of their registration have been found.

Two Hundred Volumes are now included in Phillimore's Parish Register Series, and it is estimated that in these Volumes are recorded the Marriages of upwards of Two Million persons. Thirty English Counties are comprised in the series, and the complete Marriage Registers of over Twelve Hundred Parishes have already been printed.

If every genealogist (English and American) would make a point of subscribing annually to at least one County Series (only a small expense, ranging from a half-guinea to a guinea), in a very short time all the Parish Registers of England, before 1837, would be in print.

These volumes are an absolute necessity to every genealogist. No Library of first rank, interested in English Family History, can afford to dispense with them.

Public Librarians in England, America, and the Colonies who desire to secure sets of any County should at once enter their names. Very few sets remain unsubscribed for.

Private Collectors should note that, owing to the limited editions printed (150 copies only), the volumes are being largely absorbed by public institutions and libraries, and in a short time it will be almost impossible to obtain copies. Early application for sets is requisite.

N.B. INDEXES:—In order to avoid the evil of a multiplicity of indexes, and to enable the Registers themselves to be printed as rapidly and economically as possible, indexing has been postponed until sufficient volumes have been issued to enable those of each County to have one general index, or at least to be indexed in long sets. With the approaching completion of several Counties this question has become imminent, and Subscribers will be glad to hear that the Indexes of several Counties are now in active preparation and Index Volumes will be announced at an early date.

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YORKSHIRE.

CORRESPONDENTS have constantly asked that the Marriage Registers of Yorkshire should be included in this Series and after much pressure we have consented to start this work. The *Yorkshire Parish Register Society* have done, and are doing, good work in printing Yorkshire Registers, having issued upwards of fifty parishes, besides the Register of Austerfield in the old Archdeaconry of Nottingham; but their progress in relation to the whole of such a vast county is necessarily slow and their work too often has the drawback that the Registers are printed only down to some date in the 18th century, whereas genealogists now require that all Registers printed should be brought down to the year 1837, when Civil Registration began, and prior to which date, now receding so rapidly into history, it is becoming increasingly difficult to obtain genealogical data. Again, a desire to print a large number of parishes and to produce as many volumes as possible in return for the annual subscription, frequently causes the county Societies to give undue attention to small and relatively unimportant Registers, to the neglect of those of the large towns, though the latter, with their numerous marriages of persons from distant places, and the greater time and expense involved in searching the originals, are by far the most useful to the genealogical worker.

We propose therefore to print a series of Yorkshire Marriage Registers, dealing chiefly with the towns and larger villages, and including smaller places only when they are adjacent, forming compact groups, so that the complete Marriage Registers over large areas of country are printed in each volume—a feature which has made the Nottinghamshire series so useful. We shall also print the abstracts, in every case, down to the year 1837. As Yorkshire is so large a county and as it is desirable to print as rapidly as possible in order that subscribers may have the results available for reference quickly, we intend to issue these volumes at 15/- each instead of the uniform 10/6 of the remainder of the counties in this series. This will enable us to give from 200 to 250 pages in each volume, instead of the usual 150 to 170,

and also to compile and print *an index to each volume or parish*, as the system of consolidated indexes, adopted in the other counties, is not so feasible in the case of Yorkshire.

The first two volumes of the Yorkshire series will contain the complete Marriage Registers of the important parish of ROTHERHAM (embracing also the hamlets and chapelries of *Greasborough, Kimberworth, Dalton, Brinsworth, Catcliffe and Orgreave*) from 1540 to 1837. These will be issued in two volumes at 15/- each nett. Volume I. containing the period 1540 to 1798, and Volume II. 1798 to 1837, with index to both.

Subscribers' names are now being received, and Volume I. will be issued in October. Only 150 copies are being printed, so that the Yorkshire series is certain to become scarce.

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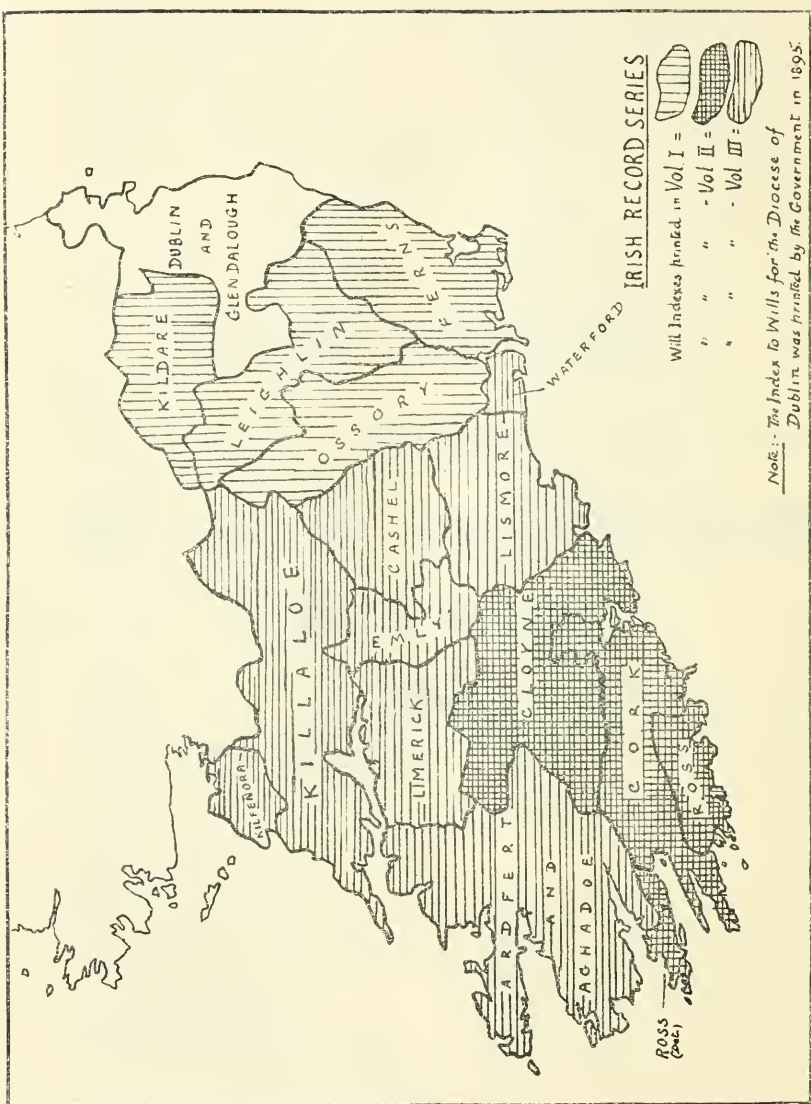
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
