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

A Note in N<sup>o</sup> 3 Register reads thus:—

“Simon Paget A.B. was licenced to the Curacy of Michael Church in the County of Somerset & Diocese of Bath & Wells the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of March, 1776—on the Nomination of M<sup>rs</sup> Elizabeth Acland—and read the Articles, &c., for the same, on Sunday the 25<sup>th</sup> of February, 1776.”

Mem: was appointed to the cure before, by D<sup>r</sup> Arnold of Wells who acted by Commission for the Purpose.
