

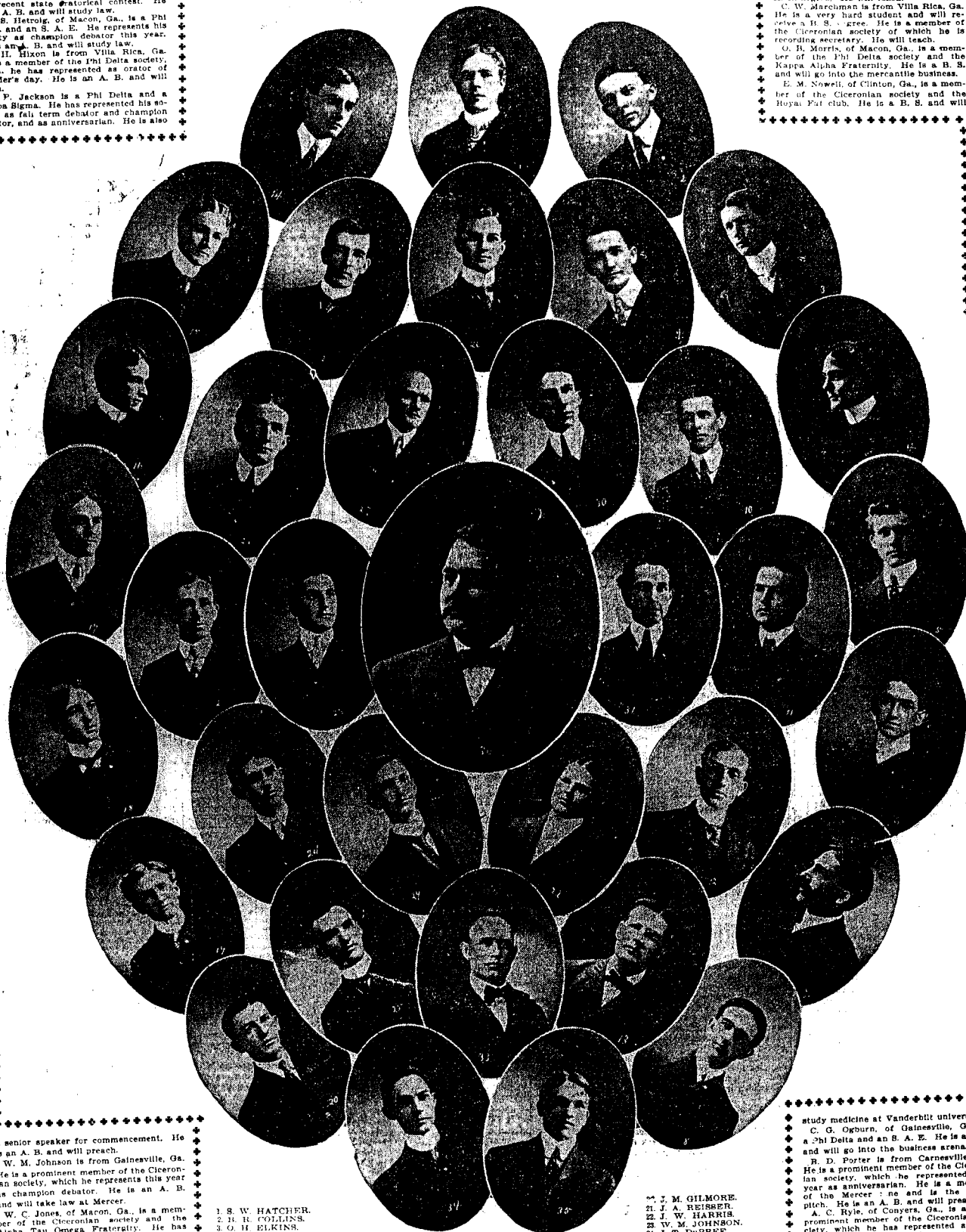
SENIOR CLASS OF MERCER UNIVERSITY 1902.
