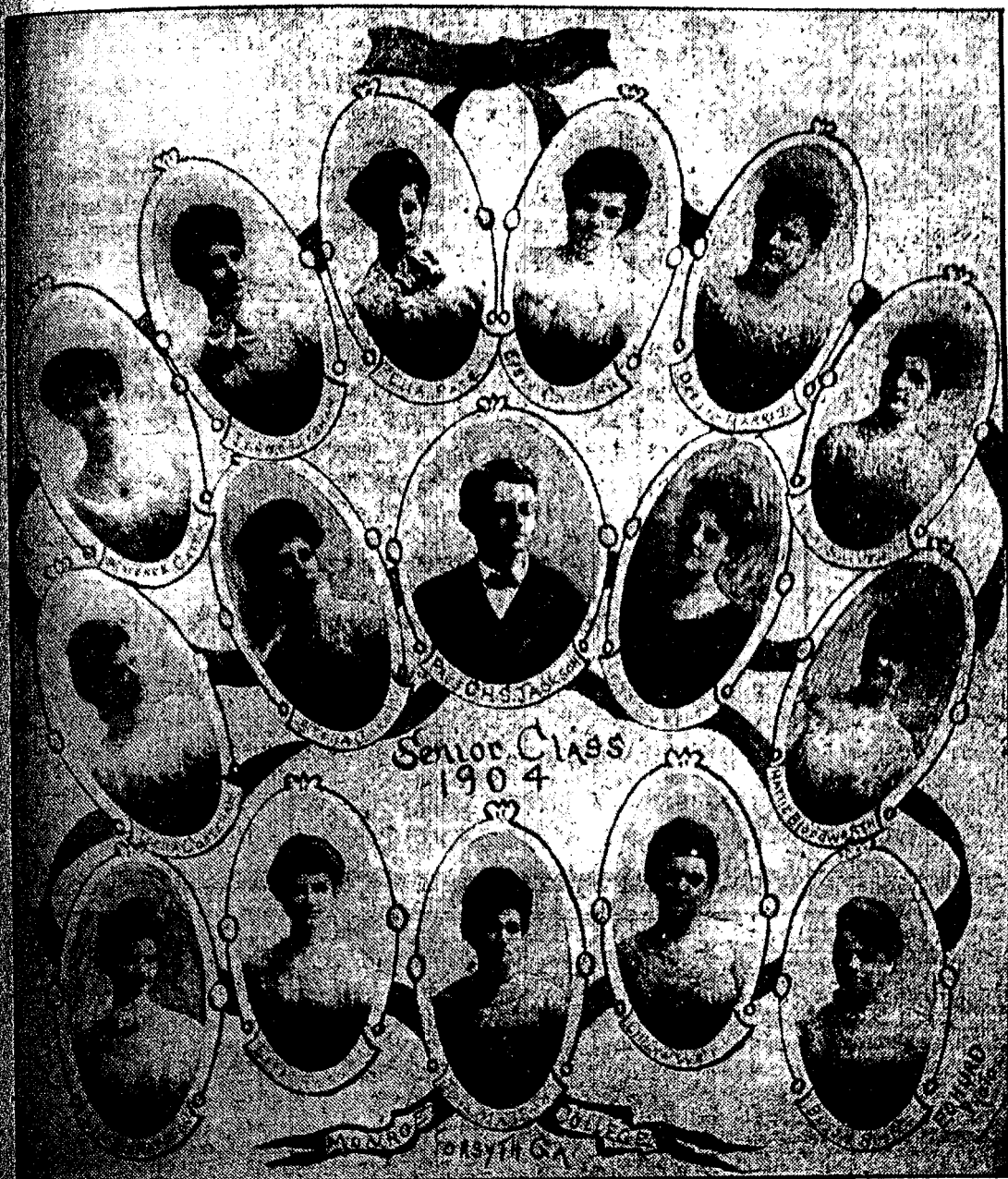


MONROE FEMALE COLLEGE WILL HAVE BRILLIANT EXERCISES
