SUPT. TEMPLE PLEASED WITH ATLANTA POSTOFFICE

Assistant Superintendent of Registry Department, Now Here, Says Atlanta Office in Fine Shape.

Henry R. Temple, assistant superintendent of the registry department in Washington, was in the city Friday. Mr. Temple has charge of the work of this department in ten states, and his visit to Atlanta had for its purpose the investigation of the local office.

Mr. Temple said that it was very probable that several changes would be made in the registry department here, but he could not tell as yet just what changes these would be.

He spoke highly of the work done by the Atlanta office, saying that it stood fourteenth in the list of the postoffices of the large cities of the country, standing at the head of the southern cities with the exception of New Orleans.

He spoke in flattering terms of the success of Station B, on Pryor street, and said that the people of Atlanta were quick to respond to improved postoffice facilities.
