The annual commencement exercises of the Georgia School of Technology, which will be held on Thursday, June 21st, will be attended by one of the strongest graduating programs in the history of the institution.

In addition to the theses which will be presented by the graduating class consisting of forty students, Nicholas Murray Butler, dean of Columbia college, New York, will be among the speakers. Addresses will also be made by Prof. K. G. Matheson, manager of the faculty, John Temple Graves and others.
