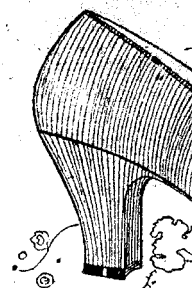
PRIZES FOR DANCERS TO BE AWARDED
