ATHENS, Ga., June 3.—R. L. Ellis, of Atlanta, will be one of the five to receive degrees from the University of Georgia School of Journalism at commencement. The others upon whom the Henry W. Grady school will confer bachelor degrees are I. H. Granath, of Fruithurst Ala., and Atlanta; Irvin P. Myerson, of Athens, M. S.; Cook, of Fitzgerald, and John D. Allen, of South Carolina.

Mr. Allen immediately after graduation will go to Baltimore, Mr., where he has accepted a position with the Baltimore Evening Sun.

There are 145 students in the Grady school this year, according to the report to the trustees. The school was established in 1921, and each year has shown an increased enrollment.

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
