In the name of God Amen I Adam Cook of Ashe County & State of North Carolina being weak in body but in perfect mind memory and Calling to mind the mortality of the body that it is ordained for all men once to die do make this last Will & Testament

First. I give my soul to God who gave it and my body to the grave to be buried in an orderly decent manner and as for such worldly good as it has pleased God to bestow on me in this life I do dispose of as follows.

First It is my real desire that all my just debts be punctually paid and what be left I give and bequeath unto my son Melchel Cook all my reading books and all my money & all my notes and Tools. I is my real desire to five Dollars to Sidney Basket & five shillings to his son George Cook & one shilling to Samuel Durmire and one shilling John Goble & shilling to Henry Smith & I do hereby constitute Melchel Cook and David Horton as Executors to this my last Will & Testament,

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 6th day of December
A.D. 1816.
