 my Executors of this my last will & testament
 all & singular it I do hereby utterly Disallow Disclaim
 & Disannul all & every other former testament
 Ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be
 my last will & testament in witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
 Seal this 5th Day
