be to god for his goodness do this 13 day of
March in the year of our Lord 1878 do make
and publish this my Last will and testament
187 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Lucy McMillon all the property that she brought
here provided she out lives me in addition
thereto I give her two choice cows 54 choice
hogs and two sheep fifty dollars in money
I also give her as a dower in my lands the
following boundaries Beginning on a white oak
near the church house running East with
my line to a stake in the county road then East
with said road to a stake in my line then North
with my line to the Road between the mill and
Solomon Gotes then with said Road on by the
mill to S. B. McMillon then with the main
Road to the beginning

To have and to hold that to occupy during
her natural life or so long as she continues
my widow and no longer I also give to
McMillon the land named in the dower
with the ballance of the land on Bathans
Creek for which he is to pay one thousand
dollars I I McMillon Eveline young Polly
Chambers Marion young Peggy Senton heirs
to be Equity divided among them or their heirs
as the Negro Property that I give my daughters
in place of land that I give to my sons has
been lost I give them 100 and twelve acres
of land known as the Turner and Kittle
Cove lands to be Equally divided between
them or sold and the price divided between
them or their heirs there is seventy acres of
land known as the coffee mine tract
that is to be sold with all ballance
of my property and the money Equally divided
with all my heirs also all the money
on hand at my death

and notes to be equally divided among
all my heirs after they are collected all
notes that I hold against any of my children
is to be accounted for both Principal and
Interest all Just debts to be Paid that I
may owe which at this time is nothing
if I owe two dollars in the world I do

constitute my Sons J. J. McMillon and J. B.
McMillon Executors in witness whereof
