

Will of Christopher C Stump

In the name of god a men I Christopher C Stump being well advanced in age and knowing the uncertainty of human life at all times I do therefore make my last will and testament.

Item 1 To my living wife Sarah B Stump I give all my property both person and real to have and to hold the same during her natural life

Item 2 To my son James A Stump I give the sum of two hundred dollars one hundred and fifty dollars of which he has received the remaining fifty dollars to be paid to said James by my son Emmett Stump within two years after my death

Equal installments of twenty five dollars each to be paid annually

Item 3 To my daughter Ellen Richardson I have already given one hundred dollars also I give her said Ellen my Candie stand and two

Item 4 To my daughter Mary A Stump I give the top of any press wash table and chest

also my dining table one chair and one coll and one bed and bedding and one rug

Item 5 To my daughter Paulina A Phillips I have already given forty dollars also I give her said Paulina one coll and part of my press Item 6th to my son Kim A Stump I give all my land one lot one cow one

horse one cow one work table all my farming utensils my bible my last table

Item 7th I direct that my medical chest chest and my Library be divided equally among all my children

Item 8th I further direct my son Kim A Stump to pay to my wife one James A Stump the sum of fifty dollars within two years after my death to be paid in six annual payments it being the same that is mentioned in the second item of this will

Item 9th in case I do not give in my life time the coll an one to my daughter Mary A Stump

& Paulina A Phillips mentioned in items 6 & 8th of this will there my son Kim A Stump is to pay to each one of them said Mary A & Paulina one coll at weaning time and one sows either

A paper purporting to be the last will and testament of C C Stump Deceased is exhibited before me the undersigned judge of probate for said county by Sarah W Stump the executrix therein mentioned and the due execution thereof by the said C C Stump by the oath and examination of John M Black & Riley Blivins The subscribing witness thereto who being duly sworn doth depose and say and each for himself deposes and saith that he is a subscribing witness to the paper writing now shown him purporting to be the last will and testament of C C Stump that the said C C Stump in the presence of this deponent subscribed his name at the end of said paper writing which is now shown him as aforesaid and which bears the date of the 28 of July 1876 And the deponent further saith that the said C C Stump the testator aforesaid did at the time of subscribing his name as aforesaid declare this said paper writing so subscribed by him and exhibited to be his last will and testament and this deponent did therewith subscribe his name at the end of said will as aforesaid witness thereto and at the request and in the presence of the said testator And this deponent further saith that at the said time when the said testator subscribed his name to the said will as aforesaid and at the time of deponents subscribing his name as an attesting witness thereto as aforesaid the said C C Stump was of sound mind & memory of full age to execute a will and was not under any constraint to the knowledge information of this deponent and further this deponent say not seriously sworn and subscribed John M Black (Sub) Riley Blivins (Sub)
