

# Will of Daniel Halloway.

Whereas, I Daniel Halloway in the County of  
Oaks and State of North Carolina have made my last  
Will and Testamant in writing bearing date the fourteent  
day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and forty eight in and by which I have  
given and bequeathed to my wife Polly Halloway one  
cow and calf, one steer, five head of hogs and one hen  
& furniture with the cooking utensils and half man  
also my crop growing, corn & wheat, also I will to my wife's  
daughter, Nancy Bangs one cow and calf, one heifer  
and bull, one bed and furniture, and one set of  
cooper tools, and one shot gun. I also will to  
my wife's son, William Bangs one cow and calf  
one set of blacksmith tools and notes to the amount  
of one hundred and eight dollars on Martin Brown  
of Wilkes County N.C. Carolina. Now therefore I do by this  
my writing which I hereby declare to be a codicil to  
my said last Will and Testamant, therefore it is  
ordered and declared that my will is that only  
the sum of one dollar a piece shall be paid to  
my heirs Phoebe Lavelle, John Halloway, Visitha  
Sparks, Sam Brundage, Polly Bangs, Daniel H. Halloway  
as the full amount bequeathed to them and the  
legacy to give to those heirs, therefore this made a  
portion of my last will and Testamant as aforesaid  
to all intents and purposes: In witness whereof I  
set my hand and the day and date above written
