

Will of Elias Bare

In the name of God amen.

I Elias Bare, Esq of the County of Ashe
and State of North Carolina, being of
sound mind and memory, will ~~hereby~~
the shortness of life and the certainty of
death, do make this my last will and testament
concerning the property with which it has
pleased God to bless me with. First I will
that my body have a decent Christian
burial. Second that all my just debt be
paid out of my personal property.

Third I will that Freddie Bare have all
my lands not deeded consisting of my
home ~~land~~ lands as I have Consecuted to
Hammon Bare & Bartlett Bare their full
share of my real estate.

Fourth I will that Freddie Bare have to
Nancy Goldiron fifty dollars in property or
money & will that Freddie Bare have to
Emery Jane Bare fifty dollars in property
or money. Fifth I will at my death all of
my personal property be sold and equally
divided between all of my heirs to wit Hammon
Bare Bartlett Bare Nancy Goldiron & Emery Jane
Bare Freddie Bare also the heirs of above
may divide the personal property they can
agree to now among them. I will that
the County of Ashe be guardian for Emery
Jane Bare also for Freddie Bare to take care
of his property till they become of age.

and this defendant thereupon subscribing his
name at the end of said will as aforesaid
witness thereto and at the request and in
the presence of the said testator and this
defendant further saith that at the said
time when the said testator subscribed his
name as aforesaid witness thereto as aforesaid
Elias Bare was of sound mind and memory
of full age to execute a will and was not under
any restraint to the knowledge of informer or
body of this defendant and further these defences
say not.
