

Will of Gardner Shepherd

In the name of God Amen  
I Gardner Shepherd of the County  
of Ashe & State of North Carolina, being of  
sound mind and memory and considering  
the uncertainty of this frail and transitory  
life do therefore make ordain and publish  
and declare this to be my last will and  
testament. That is to say. First after all  
my lawfull debts and paid and discharged  
the residue of my estate real and  
personal I give bequeath and dispose of  
as follows to wit

To my beloved wife the said and  
appertinances as now possessed by me  
in the County of Ashe and State of  
North Carolina during her widowhood  
afterwards to decend to my lawfull heirs  
Also the personal property now possessed  
by me during her widowhood

likewise I make constitute and appoint  
my son Calvin Shepherd and David Lopp  
to be Executors of this my last will and  
testament hereby revoking all former  
wills by me made.

In testimony whereof I  
have hereunto subscribed my name and  
affixt my seal the sixteenth day of  
July in the Year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and eighty.

A Paper purporting to be the last will  
and Testament of Gardner Shepherd  
deceased is exhibited before me

by the oath and examination of Elihu  
Wheaver William Lopp and David Brazelton  
the subscribing witnesses thereto who being  
duly sworn each depose and say one each  
for himself depose and say that he  
is a subscribing witness to the paper  
purporting now shown him purporting to be  
the last will and Testament of Gardner  
Shepherd, that the said Gardner Shepherd  
in the presence of this present Judge  
Elihu Weaver to subscribe his name at the  
end of said paper-will which is shown  
as aforesaid and which bears date of  
the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1880.

And the deponent further saith that the  
said Gardner Shepherd the testator of  
aforesaid did at the time of subscribing  
his name as aforesaid declare the said  
paper-will so subscribed by him and  
exhibited to be his last will and Testament  
and this deponent did thenceforth subscribe  
his name at the end of said Will as an  
attesting witness thereto and at the request  
one of them and the other two and in the  
presence of the said testator. And this deponent  
further saith that at the said time when  
the said testator subscribed his name to  
the said last will as aforesaid and at the  
time of the deponent's subscribing his name  
as an attesting witness thereto as aforesaid  
the said Gardner Shepherd was of sound mind &  
memory of full age to execute a will and was not  
under any restraint or coercion or undue influence  
or fraud of his deponent or any other person  
at the time he executed said will and at the  
16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1880
