on the 20th day of october 1831 we the commissioners appointed to lay off the widow Ellinder Brown and family's one year support provision on the day and date above ~~written~~ have performed our duty and lay leave to report in the first place we have laid out of the provisions that was on hand that is to forty Bushels of Corn at sixteen dollars two cows and calves at twenty dollars paid to winter the stock on sixteen dollars and one thousand weight of pork at thirty dollars then for such necessaries as we think the nature of the case requires that was not on hand such as sugar Coffee Salt butter ^{what} and so forth we have give her to the amount of seventy ~~five~~ dollars to purchase these articles with

above named assigned the day and date above written signed
by the Commisars
