First. All my just debts and funeral expenses shall be first fully paid. Second I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Sara E Goodman all my land her lifetime also one bay mare and two Rose Colored the Farming utensils and house hold and kitchen furniture to have and to hold her lifetime then to fall back to my four youngest boys J. R. Goodman & H. Goodman R. V. Goodman, W. W. Goodman.
Third I have give my son Lee \$100⁰⁰ and now I will him \$100 one dollar more 4th I have give my son Biary \$100⁰⁰ and now I will him \$100 one dollar more. 5th Mary & May is to have a home as long as they stay single and conduct themselves right also they are to have \$30 dollars each. 6 I have given to my daughter, Len, \$40 and now I will her \$10 or ten Dollars more also Anney, May, Lary Child \$25 Twenty five Dollars when she be comes of age 7th Jenney, Julie & Flora is to have a home as long as they stay single and conduct themselves right they are to have \$75 each when they marry or leave. 8th J. R. Goodman & H. Goodman R. V. Goodman W. W. Goodman is to share equal like in the land except W. W. Goodman is to have \$100⁰⁰ in valuation the most. 9 The rest of my stock is to go to the 4 youngest boys. 10th I also say the boys is not to sell their interest in the land till the youngest one is of age except to one another. I appoint J. R. Goodman the Executor to his will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal This April 21 1898.
