will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say:

I give and devise to my youngest Daughter Miriah
Patric two hundred acres of land said land ~~to~~
be all in one body but I give my daughter Miriah
sole right to have the lines run and establish
whenever she may desire so as to include my
manions house and all other improvements in
the two hundred acres above named.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Shurtz
and Lizz Patric the balance of the land now owner-
ed by me twenty acres more or less to be equally
divided between the two I give and devise
to my son George Patric One set of Carpenters
Tools I give and devise to each one of the
Children of my Daughter Bettie Lyalls deceased
one dollar each to be paid to them by my
Daughter Miriah Patric within two years from
my death or as soon thereafter as they may
become of age I give and devise ^{to the child} of my son
James Patric one dollar to be paid to be paid
by my Daughter Miriah Patric within two years
from my death I give and devise to my beloved
Wife Eliza Patric all of my money and personal
property what ever not otherwise disposed of in
my will to have and to hold the same for her own
free use during her natural life and at her
death whatever she may have left shall go to
my Daughter Miriah Patric and her heirs and
lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my
truly Daughter Miriah Patric my lawful Executor
to all intents and purposes to execute this my
last will and Testament according to the true
intent and meaning of the same I hereby revoke
and declare utterly void all other wills and
Testaments by me heretofore made In witness
