

The Last Will & Testament of John Bower Due
In the name of God amen

I John Bower of the County of Ashe & State of North Carolina
Being weak in Body but of a sound & disposing mind
& memory do make & declare this my last will and
Testament in this manner & form as following

I Give & Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Elizabeth Bower
the Plantation I now have upon the adjoining tract
including my Dwelling house kitchen & all other
out houses & buildings with every improvement thereon
During the Term of her natural life in satisfaction

of her Dower of all my Real Estate
& my will & desire is that the said premises be
leased from year to year or for a longer term of time
at the Description of my Executor & the necessary Rent
Paid over to the said Elizabeth Bower for her sole &
Sole use I further Give & Bequeath to my wife
Elizabeth Bower the use of one Black ^{girl} named Duke
one horse beast her own choosing Two cows her choice
all my Household & Kitchen furniture all Provisions
& Pottery on hand at the Time of my Death for
During the Term of her natural life

I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Pewz
five Dollars

I Give & Bequeath to my Beloved Sons Abdom Bower
& George Bower Twenty five Dollars each

I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Councill wife
of Jordan Councill Jr Two Negro Boys by the name of
George & Troy

I Give to my Beloved Son Abdom Bower his Executors ^{trust}
or apiece a Tract of Land on Water Creek Whence James Grimes
now living containing Ninety five acres the same more or less
also one Negro boy named Henderson to him the said Abdom
Bower to have & to hold in Trust for the sole use &
Benefit of my Daughter Catharine Grimes & her
children from ever

I Give & Bequeath to my son-in-law Jordan Councill one
black boy by the name of Ned to be his Right & Property
with this condition that he pay to my son George
Bower the Value of said boy in cash I Give & Bequeath
the amount of the Value of said Negro boy also if
taken by the said Councill & if not said boy
next to my son George Bower his Executor Administratrix
or Assignee to hold the same with every interest therein
in Trust for the Benefit of my Daughter Elizabeth Parker
& her children for ever

I Give & Bequeath my to Jordan Councill for my Negro girl
Phibe & increase which Bequeath is to take Effect after
the Death of my wife Elizabeth Bower to him the said
Jordan Councill his Executor Administratrix & Assignee
to leave & to hold in Trust for the Benefit of my
Daughter Eve Walling & her children for ever
it is my will & Desire that all the Property of what
kind soever herein Bequeathed the said Elizabeth
Bower George Bower & Jordan Councill as Trustees
for the use & Benefit of the said Catharine Gransley
Eve Walling & Elizabeth Parker & their children
as aforesaid be Valued & that my Executor cause
the Portion of each to be made equal & that the portion
or part of my Daughter Mary River be also made as
nearly equal as convenient with the Balance of my
Daughters aforesaid & for the Purpose of making my
Executor do to do it is my will that all my Property
of what kind so ever it may be not herein
specificaly Bequeathed Shall be Sold on a Reasonable Credit
by my Executor & the Proceeds of such Sale when
collected to be Equally Divided Between the Trustees
& Trust as aforesaid & the said Mary River so as to
divide the several ~~shares~~ Portions equal share &
share alike it is my will to divide her the
Plantation on which I live & other Real Property
Given to my wife Elizabeth Bower after her Death
go to my son George Bower if he will take it

at a Reasonable Valuation & Pay the other Legacies their
Proportionable Party of the Value thereof but if he will
not Take the aforesaid Premises upon the said Terms
then either of the other of my Children will be at liberty
so to Take said Premises But if Neither of them
will so Take the said Premises so as aforesaid then it
shall be Sold by my Executors to the best Bidder
on such a Tenant as shall be Designated by my Executors
& the Proceeds of such Sale when Collected Equally
Divided between all my Children as aforesaid
Share & Share alike as well as all the Personal
Property Left by my wife Elizabeth Bower at her
Death which may constitute any Part or Partiel
of my Estate Promised always that all Portions
Parties or Parcels of my Said Estate which Constitutes
Part or Share of my Daughters Catharine Grunby
Eve Walling & Elizabeth Parker Shall Go to their
Respective Trustees herein before mentioned & that the
said Trustees shall hold the same in Trust as
aforesaid for the Benefit of the said Catharine Grunby
Eve Walling & Elizabeth Parker & their Children for ever
Promised always that the said Trustees or Either of
them at any Time after the Reception of their Respective
Shares or Portions of my Estate in Trust as here in
before stated may Secure the same in the hands
of a Guardian or Guardians for the use & Benefit
of the said Catharine Grunby Eve Walling &
Elizabeth Parker & their Children as aforesaid
my will & Desire is that my Woman Grunby
have her choice of a home among my Children
to live with & I Request them to allow her to die
among them as she may choose I hereby constitute
& appoint my Sons John Bower & George Bower
& my Son-in-Law Jordan Cornhill my Lawful
Executors to all intent & Purpose to Execute this my
Last will & Testament

according to the True intent & Meaning of the Same
& Every Part of Clause there. hereby Revoking all other
I Declaring and Null & Void all other Wills & Testaments
by me heretofore made In Testimony whereof I the
said John Bower do subscribe set my hand &
Seal this 24th day of June 1838
in the presence of
