sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be  
God do this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of September A.D. 1836 make  
and publish this my last Will and Testament  
in manner following. That is to say

First. I give and bequeath unto my eldest daughter  
Peggy Two Shillings after my decease This  
making her equal with the rest. I give and  
bequeath unto my eldest son Richard One  
Hundred Dollars after my decease This ma-  
king him equal with the rest. I give and  
bequeath unto my youngest son Daniel  
One Hundred Dollars after my decease This  
making him equal with the rest. I give  
and bequeath unto my second daughter  
Susannah One Hundred Dollars after my  
decease This making her equal with the  
rest. I give and bequeath unto my young-  
est daughter Mary one Hundred Dollars  
after my decease This making her equal  
with the rest, leaving the balance to my bel-  
oved wife Hannah as long as she remains  
my widow. at her decease if there is any thing  
left to be divided equal with the heirs. and  
I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend  
Richard Green Executor of this my last  
Will and Testament.
